**BINA HEARING**

**MOTION #1:** Commissioner Kolodziej motioned and Commissioner Busa seconded to enter into the Public Hearing concerning the intent of the Board of Park Commissioners to sell \$2,000,000 General Obligation Limited Tax Park Bonds to provide the revenue source for the payment of certain outstanding obligations of the District, for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District and for the payment of the expenses incident hereto.

**EXPLANATION OF REASONS FOR PROPOSED BOND ISSUES:** Finance Director David Brink stated this is done every few years to cover the amount of bonds the District will issue during the next three years at a rate of approximately \$550,000 per year. The last time this was done was in 2017 and the next time will be in 2023. This is for land and building improvements, the maintenance of existing facilities, and for the payment and expenses for land condemned or purchased for parks and buildings.
