

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-6
2024 PROPERTY TAX LIMITATION RESOLUTION
WESTCHESTER PARK DISTRICT
10201 Bond Street
Westchester, Illinois 60154

WHEREAS, the Westchester Park District Board of Commissioners has hereby determined that it is in the best interest of the Westchester Park District to direct the County Clerk as to which funds should be limited, if necessary, to comply with the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (PTELL);

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Westchester Park District that the following levies shall be no less than the amounts indicated:

CORPORATE	\$779,500
RECREATION	\$724,000
SPECIAL RECREATION	\$150,000
BOND AND INTEREST	\$675,232

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any further reduction of the levy is required to comply with the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law, it shall be done sequentially on the following basis:

- A) That the Corporate fund levy shall be reduced only to the lesser of:
 - 1) The amount actually levied in the corporate fund plus the loss percentage; or
 - 2) The maximum allowable levy without regard to the PTELL, (i.e. that which will produce a rate equal to the tax rate ceiling).If further reductions are necessary to comply with the PTELL, then

- B) The Recreation fund levy shall be reduced only to the lesser of:
 - 1) The amount actually levied in the recreation fund plus the loss percentage; or
 - 2) The maximum allowable levy without regard to the PTELL, (i.e. that which will produce a rate equal to the tax rate ceiling).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the office of the Cook County Clerk.
