General Information

The Westchester Park District, organized in 1956, is governed by a five-member Board of Park Commissioners, elected on an at-large, non-partisan basis to serve a four-year term without compensation. The Commissioners elect officers, set policy, and appoint an Executive Director responsible for the daily administration of the Park District. The District employs 13 full-time staff and more than 100 part-time and seasonal staff. The Board also appoints the Park District Attorney, Secretary, Treasurer, and Independent Auditors.

Purpose

The Mission of the Westchester Park District is to provide quality parks, facilities, and fun activities to enrich the leisure time of our community.

Facilities

The Westchester Park District manages more than 50 acres of parks and three facilities, listed below. The District offers eight parks, seven playgrounds, an outdoor swimming pool, an outdoor ice rink, and a dog park. The District also provides outdoor tennis, pickleball, and volleyball courts, ball diamonds, soccer fields, football fields, walking trails and pathways. Indoor programs include preschool and daycare, general recreation classes, an indoor playground, and a fitness center. The District also provides banquet facilities.
